Consent Items

- 18-0389 Amends a contract with CenturyLink, LLC., by adding \$2,000,000 for a new total of \$22,000,000 to add additional telephone services to the existing agreement for the City's leased line, data, and telephone services, allowing the City to reduce cost of CenturyLink telephone services and increasing the resiliency of the City's telephone systems, citywide. No change to contract duration (TECHS-CE90535-04).
- 18-0396 Amends a contract with SkillSoft Corporation by adding \$287,006 for a new total of 1,724,997.95 and one year for a new end date of 5-29-19 for learning content and a limited learning management system (LMS) for the Office of Human Resources (201310840-4).

- 18-0397 Approves an exception to the time limitation in the Amended and Restated Service Plans of the Denver Gateway Center Metropolitan District and the Denver Gateway Meadows Metropolitan District to allow bond issuance payable after 2046 for the public road, drainage, parks, water and sewer improvements needed for development, in Council District 11.
- 18-0399 Approves a purchase order with Optiv Security, Inc., for \$1,069,950.66 for a web content filtering system that protects users from malicious websites and provides a secure gateway to the internet for all City users (PO-00037018).
- 18-0403 Amends an intergovernmental agreement with Denver Public Schools (DPS) by adding five years for a new end date of 4-1-23 and amending the terms to make available Public, Education and Government (PEG) funds to support an educational access TV station and to purchase video and audio capital equipment necessary for production content and hands-on experience that educates and benefits students and the community, citywide (TECHS -201309953-01).
