- Approves a performance grant agreement with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the 2018 allocations of \$6,859,369 through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program to improve housing and living conditions and expand economic opportunities for low- and moderate-income persons (201844783).
- Approves a performance grant agreement with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the 2018 allocation of \$2,017,134 through the Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS (HOPWA) program to provide housing and supportive services designed to prevent homelessness for persons with Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome (AIDS) or related diseases, citywide (201844785).
- Approves a performance grant agreement with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the 2018 allocation of \$2,362,617 for HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) to provide funding for the city's housing development activities including for building, buying, and rehabilitating affordable housing for rent or homeownership and providing direct rental assistance to low-income residents, citywide (201844784).
