26	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUN	TY

29	Section 1. A new Fund is hereby established in the Economic Opportunity Special Rev	/enue				
30	Fund Series, Accounting No. 17000, a "Denver Small Business Investment" Fund, Accounting No.					
31	17805, for the purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of program dollars.					
32	Section 2. Monies received from sales tax revenue generated from one percent of the s	pecial				

retail marijuana sales tax, private donations, and other sources of revenue, for Accounting No. 17805

shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 17000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

**Section 3.** Program expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Denver Small Business Investment" Fund, Accounting No. 17805 to be expended by the Executive Director of the Denver Economic Development and Opportunity. Allowable expenses include various investment programs to support businesses and organizations in the City and County of Denver, including but not limited to loans and other investment products, grants, outreach, operations and administration, and technical assistance, including assistance specific to Cannabis Social Equity applicants. Priority is placed on businesses owners who have traditionally lacked access to affordable funding or investment products or are located in Denver's most-under-resourced communities. This Fund is appropriated and non-lapsing.

**Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
