**A BILL**

**For an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 84, Series of 2019, to change the name of the “College Affordability” Special Revenue Fund to the “Prosperity Denver” Special Revenue Fund.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance Number 84, Series of 2019, established the College Affordability Special Revenue fund, Fund number 11871, to administer the program approved by Denver voters in the 2018 election and supported by a 0.08 percentage point increase to the sales tax rate; and

**WHEREAS**, since the SRF’s establishment, the organization responsible for administering the program changed its name to Prosperity Denver; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to change the name of the College Affordability Fund to the Prosperity Denver Fund to align the Fund’s name with the administering organization’s name;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** Ordinance No. 84, Series of 2019, is hereby amended to reflect that the “College Affordability” Fund is now named the “Prosperity Denver” Fund.

**Section 2.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
