10	the public hearing, that the map amendment set forth below conforms with applicable City laws, is
11	consistent with the City's adopted plans, furthers the public health, safety and general welfare of the
12	City, will result in regulations and restrictions that are uniform within the S-MX-5 district, is justified
13	by one of the circumstances set forth in Section 12.4.10.8 of the Denver Zoning Code, and is
14	consistent with the neighborhood context and the stated purpose and intent of the proposed zone
15	district;
16	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF
17	DENVER:
18	Section 1. That upon consideration of a change in the zoning classification of the land area
19	hereinafter described, Council finds:
20	a. The land area hereinafter described is presently classified as R-4 with waivers.
21	b. It is proposed that the land area hereinafter described be changed to S-MX-5.
22 23 24	Section 2. That the zoning classification of the land area in the City and County of Denver described as follows shall be and hereby is changed from R-4 with waivers to S-MX-5:
