






- Significant Latinx community

- Waste and safety concerns in Athmar Park area parks




NORTH DENVER (5 submitted COIs)

- Cole/Clayton area lack of affordable housing




EAST COLFAX (7 submitted COIs)

- Desire to unite community into one district




MONTBELLO (7 submitted COIs)

LOWRY (9 submitted COIs)


- Traffic issues


- Crime

- Lack of shopping options






COLFAX (2 submitted COIs)

CAPITOL HILL (9 submitted COIs)



NORTHEAST PARK HILL










COLLEGE VIEW (4 submitted COIs)
