EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

DPL received a grant from DDPHE as part of the Healthy Food for Denver's Kids program to provide food boxes with fresh, nutritious food to Denver youth and their families. It is anticipated that we will receive \$750,000 per year for the next three years for this program from DDPHE.

Food boxes will include fresh fruits and vegetables, bread, pasta, beans, rice and in some cases (depending on the branch location, meat and eggs.

Boxes are distributed on a first-come, first-serve basis and will be available until supplies run out each week.
