DSOC/SOLE Background

- DSOC is a street outreach program, led by Colorado Coalition for the Homeless with subcontractors Saint Francis Cener and Urban Peak
- This contract combines the longstanding work of DSOC with the new outreach work started as part of pandemic response (SOLE)
- Amendment to extend the contract term of the 2021 contract





Outreach Teams

Denver Street Outreach Collaborative

- Deep case management support to people experiencing unsheltered homelessness
- Wrap-around service support from distribution of basic needs to coordination of primary and behavioral health care
- Comprised of 18 outreach staff and a behavioral health navigator

Strategic Outreach to Large Encampments

- Affiliate team with DSOC focused on needs of large, priority encampments
- Comprised of 3 outreach workers, a peer, and nurse

Early Intervention Team

- Works in smaller camps and outreaching specific individuals
- Resource connections, including SNAP, HMIS/OneHome enrollment.
- Responds to PocketGov reports

DPD Homeless Outreach Team

- Responsible to calls regarding people experiencing homelessness across Denver
- Support large encampment cleanups
- Responds when people experiencing homelessness are victims of crime

Support Team Assisted Response (STAR) and Crisis Intervention Response Unit (CIRU)

- MHCD co-responder teams, providing behavioral health response to 911 crisis calls
- Licensed social worker responds with police/paramedics to assess and coordinate long-term supports
- Not specifically intended to respond to individuals in homelessness, but frequently responds to homeless crises

Substance Use Navigators

 Denver Health/DPD partnership proactively outreaches and assists individuals toward substance use treatment

Denver Public Library Community Resource Program

- Facility-based services connecting guests to resources and programs
- Two-year grant funded outreach program currently operating which provides access to technology.

- Denver Street Outreach Collaborative (DSOC)
 and Strategic Outreach to Large Encampments
 (SOLE) utilizes a model of street outreach that
 relies upon consistent, long-term, trusting
 relationships between outreach workers, a case
 manager, a licensed behavioral health care
 provider, peer specialists, Registered Nurses
 and people, both adult and youth, experiencing
 unsheltered homelessness
- Outreach to contact 6500 individuals annually through the DSOC and SOLE programs
