

Proclamation No. 22-0742 Mile High Youth Corps Day

WHEREAS, Mile High Youth Corps' mission to help youth make a difference in themselves and their community through meaningful service opportunities and educational experiences has had tremendous impact in the City and County of Denver for 30 years; and

WHEREAS, Mile High Youth Corps started with 10 young adults in 1992 to help keep parks in Denver clean and maintained has grown to serve 250 young adults annually; and

WHEREAS, Mile High Youth Corps has provided more than 4,700 young adults with access and opportunity to enhance their skills in career pathways in land conservation, energy & water conservation, construction and healthcare during their 30 year history; and

WHEREAS, Mile High Youth Corps has retrofitted the homes of 45,000 residents in the metro area with energy and water saving measures as well as reducing their utility bills; and

WHEREAS, Mile High Youth Corps continues to combine meaningful paid service opportunities in career pathways with education and personal exploration to help young adults discover their strengths and learn to lead; and

WHEREAS, Mile High Youth Corps celebrates 30 years of positive impact on youth, community and the environment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the Council of the City and County of Denver recognizes June 23rd as Mile High Youth Corps Day and recognizes the contribution Mile High Youth Corps has made to Denver during its 30 year history.

Section 2. That the Clerk of the City and County of Denver shall affix the seal of the City and County of Denver to this proclamation and that a copy be transmitted to Jeslin Shahrezaei.
