A RESOLUTION

To set a public hearing relating to the adoption of the Sun Valley Homes Urban Redevelopment Plan and directing the Denver Urban Renewal Authority to take certain actions in connection with the hearing.

WHEREAS, the Denver City Council desires to set a public hearing on the adoption of the Sun Valley Homes Urban Redevelopment Plan pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-25-107(3); and

WHEREAS, Denver City Council desires to delegate the responsibility for notice to the Denver Urban Renewal Authority (the "Authority").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Date, Time and Location of the Sun Valley Homes Urban Redevelopment Plan Public Hearing. The City Council shall conduct a public hearing on the Sun Valley Homes Urban Redevelopment Plan. The public hearing shall be on Monday, August 29, 2022, at 5:30 p.m., or as soon as possible thereafter, in Council Chambers in the City and County Building located at 1437 Bannock Street, in Denver, Colorado.

Section 2. Other Actions and Notices. The Authority is delegated the authority and directed to give all written notices and publications required by C.R.S. § 31-25-107, including those required under C.R.S. § 31-25-107(9.5).

Section 3 Plan Submittal. That the Sun Valley Homes Urban Redevelopment Plan be submitted to the City Council and Board of Equalization of the City, sitting as the Board of County Commissioners in accordance with the Charter of the City.

Section 4. That the Clerk of the City and County of Denver shall attest and affix the seal of the City and County of Denver to this Resolution.
