27	Section 1. A new fund is hereby established in the Grant and Other Money Projects Fund				
28	Series, Accounting No. 38000, the "Globeville TIF Improvements Fund," Accounting No. 38381, for				
29	the purpose of accounting for appropriations based on DURA-projected property tax increment				
30	revenues from various taxing entities as provided in that Amended and Restated Globeville				
31	Commercial Urban Redevelopment Area Cooperation Agreement among Adams County, City and				
32	County of Denver, and DURA, and the Project Funding Agreement.				
33	Section 2. Monies received supporting the Globeville Commercial Urban Redevelopment Area

Cooperation Agreement and the Project Funding Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of

the City and credited to the Grant and Other Money Projects Fund Accounting No. 38000, which is

set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver. The Department of Finance is authorized to adjust the appropriation amounts during the term of the Project Funding Agreement, administratively, based upon annual DURA revenue projections, never to exceed the amount of tax increment revenue received from DURA and based upon reimbursement of actual project invoices.

**Section 3.** Expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Globeville TIF Improvements Fund," Accounting No. 38381, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure. This Fund is appropriated and non-lapsing.

**Section 4.** That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure, is as follows:

The foregoing authorizes expenditures for the implementation of projects to further the objectives of the Globeville Commercial Urban Redevelopment Plan, as governed by the Project Funding Agreement for Globeville Improvements between the City, Adams County, and DURA.

**Section 5.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
