24	city concern, except for any matter that is scheduled	I for either a formal or a courtesy public hearing	
25	at that meeting or any future meeting of Council. An	yone wishing to comment on a matter	
26	scheduled for a public hearing shall be requested to	reserve their comments until the hearing in	
27	question.		
28	(a) Persons wishing to address Council at	a general public comment session shall	
29	register their intention to do so online, by phone, or	in person at the City Council central office	
30	beginning at 12:00 p.m. <u>11:00 a.m.</u> on the Friday be	fore the general public comment session.	
31	Registration period will end at 4:00 3:00 p.m. the da	y of the general public comment session.	
32	Speakers shall be recognized to speak in the order	of registration by priority level. Speakers who	
33	have not addressed Council during a general public	comment session in the previous 90 days will	

1	have first priority. Speakers who have not addressed Council at the general public comment			
2	session in the previous week shall be given second priority. Those who spoke at the previous			
3	week's meeting will have third priority.
