Some of our accomplishments to date that have benefited Denver include:

- Informing Denver's Sustainable Food Policy Council about policy considerations related to regional food system infrastructure
- Collaborating with GoFarm and Eaton Senior Resource Center, both of which are located in Jefferson County, to deliver produce and prepared meals to Denver's Villa Park neighborhood.
- Building out a mobile market / farm stand concept with Sprout City Farms (some of their farmland is in Jeffco). This concept will serve Denver residents by increasing access to local fresh foods at the neighborhood level
- The Food in Communities Sheridan/W. Colfax and East Colfax/NW Aurora Community Coalitions have informed the quality of life / food strategies that will be incorporated Denver's neighborhood plans East Neighborhood Plan and the West Area Neighborhood Plan.
- Leveraging funding, food and other resources (e.g., PPE, supplies, boxes) during COVID to increase access to emergency food assistance for Denver residents
