A BILL

For an ordinance naming the pocket park at 25 South Bryant Street as “Ulibarri Park”.

WHEREAS, the City County of Denver acquired the land on which a park sits, informally known as “Bryant and Ellsworth” Park, City and County of Denver, in or about 1946, located in the Valverde neighborhood at approximately 25 S. Bryant Street, Denver, Colorado 80219; and

WHEREAS, the park was designated in accordance with City Charter in 1956; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the procedure established by the Department of Parks and Recreation’s Naming Policy, the Valverde Neighborhood Association and Evon Lopez, Elaine and Fred Ulibarri’s daughter, submitted a proposal to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board to name the park at 25 S. Bryant Street “Ulibarri Park”; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the naming is in recognition of Elaine and Fred Ulibarri; their community, civil rights and cultural activism, particularly as a part of the Chicano movement in Denver; and as exceptional residents in the Valverde neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation supports the proposed naming of this park; and

WHEREAS, the Denver Parks and Recreation Advisory Board voted at its meeting on July 13, 2022, to recommend the naming of the park at 25 S. Bryant Street as “Ulibarri Park”.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the park at 25 S. Bryant Street be and the same is hereby named, and shall be known as, ULIBARRI PARK.

Section 2. That this action shall be effective upon the final adoption of the ordinance.
