6 7 8 9 10	For an ordinance to amend Ordinance 1289, Series of 2021, to authorize aligning current year appropriations in the fund with the actual revenue received in the prior year and to change the program name to the "Malone Fund".			
11	WHEREAS, Ordinance 1289, Series of 2021 created the "Denver Small Business Investment"			
12	Fund to use a portion of the existing retail marijuana sales tax revenue to invest in various programs			
13	that provide funding and technical support to small businesses in the City and County of Denver			
14	seeking to start, restart, restructure, improve upon or grow in their endeavors; and			
15	WHEREAS, said fund also supports technical business assistance for Cannabis Social			
16	Equity applicants; and			
17	WHEREAS, said fund is an appropriated fund, with the annual appropriation established			
18	based on the projected revenue from the fund's portion of retail marijuana sales tax revenue; and			
19	WHEREAS, similar Special Revenue Funds whose primary revenue source is generated by			
20	sales tax include a provision to ensure that the appropriation in the current year can be adjusted to			
21	align with the revenue received in the prior year; and			
22	WHEREAS, this provision was inadvertently omitted in this fund's originating ordinance; and			
23	WHEREAS, the City wishes to amend Ordinance 1289, Series of 2021, to change the name			
24 25	of Fund 17805 and to account for revenue received in the prior year; and			
26	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY			
27	OF DENVER:			
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29	Section 1. Sections 1 of Ordinance No. 1289, Series of 2021 is hereby amended to read as			
30	follows:			
31	"Section 1. A new Fund is hereby established in the Economic			
32	Opportunity Special Revenue Fund Series, Accounting No. 17000the "Denver			
33	Small Business Investment Malone" Fund, Accounting No. 17805, for the			
34	purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of program dollars.			

Section 2. Sections 3 of Ordinance No. 1289, Series of 2021 is hereby amended
 to read as follows:

3 **Section 3.** Program expenditures are hereby authorized for the 4 "Denver Small Business Investment Malone" Fund, Accounting No. 17805 to be expended by the Executive Director of the Denver Economic Development 5 and Opportunity. Allowable expenses include various investment programs to 6 7 support businesses and organizations in the City and County of Denver, 8 including but not limited to loans and other investment products, grants, 9 outreach, operations and administration, and technical assistance, including 10 assistance specific to Cannabis Social Equity applicants. Priority is placed on 11 businesses owners who have traditionally lacked access to affordable funding 12 or investment products or are located in Denver's most-under-resourced 13 communities. This Fund is appropriated and non-lapsing.

Section 3. A new Section 4 is hereby added to Ordinance No. 1289, Series of 2021, to read as
 follows:

17Section 4. To ensure that the correct amount of revenue is18dedicated to this voter-approved program, the amount appropriated each year19shall be increased or decreased by the difference between (1) the prior year's20appropriation that was based upon estimated revenues and (2) the actual21revenues received in the prior year as determined by the annual audit of the22City's financial statements, per fiscal year-end close.

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Section 4. The prior Section 4 of Ordinance No. 1289, Series of 2021, is hereby
amended to be a new Section 5, to read as follows:

26 Section 4<u>5</u>. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of 27 Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record 28 entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the 29 purposes of this Ordinance."
