14	replacement of Skyline Park Local Maintenance District ("Skyline Park LMD"), for the upcoming year,

(d) The real property within Skyline Park LMD will be benefited in an amount equal to or
in excess of the amount to be assessed against said property because of the continuing care,
operation, security, repair, maintenance and replacement of said Skyline Park LMD.

31 **Section 2.** The annual cost of the continuing care, operation, security, repair, maintenance 32 and replacement of Skyline Park LMD to be assessed against the real properties, exclusive of 33 improvements thereon, benefited are hereby approved.
