- This request will amend the existing Fee on Disposable Bags to align with requirements of the state law HB 21-1162, the Plastic Pollution Prevention Act, which imposes a fee on disposable bags in the same amount as Denver's fee, but differs in some ways. Specifically, the proposed changes to Denver's ordinance are intended to:
 - Clarify definitions of stores and materials
 - Exempt restaurants from bag fee/ban but include farmers markets
 - Allow CCD to require periodic reporting on retailer's use of their share of the fee revenue through rules & regs
 - o Adopt the state's timeline for banning plastic bags and polystyrene containers
 - o Articulate the enforcement process, penalties, and appeals
