6	(the "Advisory Board") for the District, and s	pecified that such Advisory Board should, subject to the
7	approval of the Board of Directors, conduct and manage certain affairs of the District as the	
8	authorized agent of the Board of Directors in	ncluding certain financial and legal affairs; and
9	WHEREAS, the said Ordinance No.	463, Series of 2009, also calls for the Advisory Board to
20	prepare, hold a public hearing on, deliver ar	nd recommend to the Board of Directors, at least once a
21	year, a Work Plan, Budget, Capital Charges	, and Maintenance Charges (as such terms are defined
22	in the Creation Ordinance) for the next succ	eeding fiscal year; and,
23	WHEREAS, following due notice, the	Advisory Board held a public hearing on September 27,
24	2022, on the proposed Capital Charges, M	aintenance Charges, Work Plan and Budget, and has
25	prepared, delivered and recommended to th	e Board of Directors for its approval of the District Work
26	Plan, Budget, Capital Charges, and Mainter	ance Charges for the 2023 Fiscal Year; and
27	WHEREAS, in an election held on	November 3, 2009, the eligible electors of the District
28	approved ballot issues authorizing the cre	ation of the District, and the collection, retention and
29	spending of revenues in the amounts not les	s than as specified in the proposed 2023 Work Plan and

BY AUTHORITY

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- **Section 1.** That the 2023 Work Plan and Budget for the District as filed in the Office of the City Clerk, ex-officio Secretary of the District, in File No. 2009-0629-AH, be and hereby are adopted and approved.
- **Section 2.** The sum of money identified for each fund in the 2023 Budget for expenditure in the 2023 Fiscal Year is hereby appropriated for such purpose.
- **Section 3**. That the Capital Charges and Maintenance Charges set forth in the schedules filed with the Office of the City Clerk, ex-officio Secretary of the District, are hereby imposed on each property within the District boundaries and such amount of money, being necessary to be raised from Capital Charges and Maintenance Charges for the purpose of the District's expenses as set forth in the 2023 Budget, is hereby approved.
- **Section 4**. That the fiscal year of the District shall begin on the first day of January and end on the last day of December each year.
- **Section 5**. That the City Clerk of the City and County of Denver, acting ex officio as the Secretary of the Board of Directors of the District, shall attest and affix the seal of the District to this Resolution.
