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7 **Levying upon all taxable property within the City and County of Denver taxes for the**
8 **year 2022, to be collected in 2023, for purposes authorized by law for School District**
9 **No. 1 in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.**

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11 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

12 **Section 1.** That there is hereby levied for the year 2022 upon all taxable property within
13 School District No. 1 in the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado, the taxes in mills
14 per dollar of assessed valuation, set forth in the following tabulation, the proceeds of the several
15 levies to be paid into the respective funds named:

25 it would have passed the remaining parts or subsections of this resolution if it had known that such
26 other part or parts or subsection or subsections thereof would be illegal or unconstitutional.
