Amendment to 22-1635: Concerning Changing the Language of the Referred Question to Appear on the Ballot

Councilmembers,

I would like to amend Council Bill 22-1635 with the following particulars:

On page 2, lines 12-16, strike "Shall the voters of the City and County of Denver authorize the release of the City-owned conservation easement on privately owned property known as the Park Hill Golf Course, which requires the land to be used primarily for golf-related purposes, and allow for commercial and residential development, including affordable housing, and public regional park, trail and open space.", and replace with "Shall the voters of the City and County of Denver authorize the release of the City-owned conservation easement on privately owned property known as Park Hill Golf Course, which requires the land to be preserved for open space in general and a public golf course in particular, and instead allow for privately-owned residential and commercial development?"

Explanation: This amendment removes leading and unnecessary language in the ballot question while maintaining sufficient information to meet the intent of ballot initiative 301.
