Teresa Ortiz is a Denver native and current resident of the RiNo neighborhood for over 20 years. She spent much of her time as a child and teenager playing recreational sports at Globeville Rec. Center (now Birdseed Collective) and lifeguarding at Argo Park—which is where her love for her community and also her conviction to advocate for underprivileged communities, like her own, was established.

In high school, Teresa served on the Board of Directors for a grassroots non-profit organization named, Padres y Jovenes Unidos (PJU). PJU spearheaded systemic reformation surrounding student incarceration for minor offenses within Denver Public schools and the Denver Police Department. She was an award-winning and recognized student leader and organizer at Denver North High School that held people in positions of power accountable and, as a result, had the privilege of meeting U.S. Secretary of Education at the time, Mr. Arne Duncan to discuss the nation-wide issue of the "School-To-Prison Pipeline" within our U.S. school system. Teresa worked closely with attorneys at The Advancement Project, the Denver Public Schools Superintendent, The Chief of Police, students, and even parents within our communities during her involvement with PJU.

Teresa spent four years at Regis University on an academic scholarship on her way to earning her Undergrad in Accounting beginning of Fall 2014. Throughout her time in college, she enjoyed her work study position with the department of Diversity, Engagement, and Inclusion—hosting inclusive events and advocating for the growing diversity at this private institution. Not only was Teresa a first-generation college student at this time, but she was also a new, young mother at the age of 17 years old. Teresa proved that commitment, drive, and hard work is simply a choice of attitude that anyone can make, no matter the circumstance.

During Teresa's 3rd and 4th year in college, her mother Carolina, who single-handedly raised her and her older sister Lulu, was diagnosed with Stage III Breast Cancer. Her mother was her and her daughters only source of support and income at the time and as you can imagine, their worlds quickly became unraveled as her mother fought for her life and Teresa fought for her chance at defying odds and earning her degree. As a result of this shattering life event, Teresa turned all of her focus towards finding a career/work option that would allow her to become financially-independent for her daughter and herself much quicker than anticipated.

After meeting with a few trusted friends and speaking to her mentors, Teresa had no choice but to make the devastating decision to drop out of college her last semester of her 4th year of college. She had no other choice but to return to work full-time in order to avoid homelessness and bring food to the table for her and her family. She began doing book-keeping for small businesses and waitressing full-time at one of Denver's best restaurants of nearly 30 years, Café Brazil. In her spare time, when she was not serving tables or raising her daughter, she was studying to become a licensed real estate agent in the state of Colorado.
