A BILL

**For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase in the Parks
Legacy Special Revenue Fund.**

WHEREAS, the Denver Parks and Recreation (DPR) is seeking approval to purchase
capital equipment to support the operation of an in-house irrigation construction team; and

WHEREAS, the new in-house irrigation construction team will support smaller park irrigation
projects and efficiencies; and

WHEREAS, said capital equipment purchase would be funded from the Parks Legacy
Special Revenue Fund, which has sufficient appropriation to support the expense; and

WHEREAS, DPR requires the authorization to purchase the irrigation equipment from the
Parks Legacy Fund budget appropriation;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY
OF DENVER:**

Section 1. From the Parks Legacy Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 15828, the
Executive Director of Parks and Recreation, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized
to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:

and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary
to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
