

Department of Parks & Recreation On-Call Material Placement

Purpose and Use of Agreements:

The purpose of these On-Call contracts is to provide services with Denver Parks and Recreation for on-call material purchase, delivery and placement in Denver parks. The two main sites for work are playgrounds and medians but may also include other park spaces, gardens, parkways, etc. Materials to be placed may include mulch, landscape rock, cobblesand, gravel, breeze, soil, and playground material such as engineered wood fibar. Fibar is to be refilled at DPR playgrounds at least once per year. Many locations require a refill twice per year depending on use. Playgrounds are typically refilled with fibar in the spring and refreshed in the fall if needed. Median material placement will happen throughout the year on an as-needed basis. The agreements are for a three year term.

Procurement:

2 firms were awarded the contracts for this work from a RFP, Pioneer Landscape Centers, Inc. and Bedrock LLC (dba Ground Solutions).

Contracts Description:

Each contract has a three (3) year term with the capacity of \$800,000.

These contracts do not commit funds, nor do they guarantee any amount to the firms. These contracts are not an authorization of work. Authorization or work and commitment of funds are made via work order on an as needed basis.
