Runway 17L-35R Pavement Rehabilitation and Electrical Upgrade

Purpose and Use of Agreement(s)

This project is a continuation of the DEN Pavement Management Program. The primary reason for this project is to improve the pavement condition of the Runway 17L-35R complex as a means of sustaining the Airport's current investment, fulfilling our FAA grant assurance obligations, and maintaining our Part 139 certification.

Contract(s) Description

This project is a continuation of the DEN Pavement Management Program (PMP). The primary reason for this project is to improve the pavement condition of the Runway 17L-35R complex as a means of sustaining DEN's current investment, fulfilling our FAA grant assurance obligations, and maintaining our Part 139 certification. Additionally, DEN has been systematically updating portions of the airfield electrical and lighting systems from incandescent to LED as opportunities and budget allow. This project will provide the operational closure window needed to complete that conversion for the Runway 17L-35R complex, to replace aging and worn electrical infrastructure (as needed), and to remove and replace the worn surface painted pavement markings for the entire complex. Additionally, the project would address the need for relocating supplemental windcones and RI/O Cabinets outside of the Runway Object Free Area as per FAA requirements. Supplemental scope includes the installation of CCTV units near both of the Runway Aiming Points, the installation of a Runway Weather Information System, as well as mitigation of Runway and High-Speed Taxiway friction issues. This opportunity was awarded to the lowest bidder for \$41,713,440.13. The duration of the project will be 140 calendar days from Notice to Proceed (NTP).
