AutoReturn US, LLC, was awarded a contract through the RFP process to provide Vehicle Impound Management (VIM) software. This software is used primarily by the Denver Sheriff's Dept. (DSD) at the Vehicle Impound Facility (VIF) but is also used by the Denver Police Dept. and the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure.
