12	WHEREAS, Denver has experienced a significant influx of migrants and asylum seekers arriving		
13	from the southern boarder since December 2022; and		
14	WHEREAS, the City activated the Emergency Operations Center, and agencies and		
15	departments within the City and County of Denver have been providing services, including shelter,		
16	food, and other needed services on an emergency basis; and		
17	WHEREAS, the City desires to coordinate services and funding in a centralized manner; and		
18	WHEREAS, companion ordinance CB23-0829 is also being submitted to rescind budget,		
19	transfer cash, and appropriate funds for this new SRF; and		
20	WHEREAS, the City requires a new Special Revenue Fund to receive revenue and administer		
21	program services and related expenses;

23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF		
24	DENVER:

26	Section 1. A new Fund is hereby established in the Human Services Special Revenue Fund		
27	Series, Accounting No. 13000, the "Border Crisis Response" Fund, Accounting No. 13809, for the		
28	purpose of providing support to programs and services for migrants and asylum seekers arriving in		
29	Denver from other countries.		
30	Section 2. Monies received from cash transfers from the General Fund and other city funds		
31	and other sources of program income for the Border Crisis Response Special Revenue Fund sha		
32	be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Fund No. 13000, which is set forth and		
33	described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.		
34	Section 3. Expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Border Crisis Response" Fund,		
35	Accounting No. 13809, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Department of Human		

Services. Authorized expenditures for Accounting No. 13809 include but are not limited to personnel,
 services and supplies, equipment, and other costs related to providing services to people arriving in
 Denver from other countries. This fund is revenue based and non-lapsing.

Section 4. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized
and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be
necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
