Ordinance will allow the execution of the grant agreement between CCD and the State of Colorado regarding the FY23 UASI funds. The ordinance will also allow MOOEM, as the administrator for this grant, to procure the following capital equipment on behalf of Denver or neighboring UASI agencies with this grant:

- A portable shower unit (Denver – portable showering unit for use in emergency situations including evacuation sheltering or wildfire events)
- A generator quick connection and installation (Town of Bennett – to provide emergency sheltering capabilities should power go out at the rec center in town)
- 2 large platform bomb robots (Arapahoe and Douglas counties, large bomb robots used for approaching, diffusing or detonating explosive devices, current capability is beyond repair and this purchase will improve existing capability)
- A mobile commander post (Wheatridge for managing complex law enforcement situations in the field)
- Chemical detectors and supplies (North Metro Fire Dept, chemical detectors for identifying dangerous chemicals in the area when on calls)
- Multipurpose all hazards rescue vehicle (Mountain View Fire Rescue – provides enhanced response capability for SWAT medics to respond to emergencies and provide patient evacuations in dangerous environments)
- 3 decedent transport vehicles (Denver, Douglas and Boulder 1 each increases regional capability to transport decedents from hospitals or scenes – will be the same as last year’s ME van – non-electric – Denver ME and Boulder and Douglas Coroners do not have infrastructure to support an electric vehicle. DOTI has agreed to take on maintenance of the Denver vehicle)
