5. General description or background of proposed request. Attach executive summary if more space needed:

This ordinance request seeks to transfer and appropriate \$1,500,000 from Fund 15828 into Fund 36050 to provide funding in support of the acquisition of 4458 North Pearl Street and 4441 North Washington Street for DPR. The City and County of Denver has a signed Purchase and Sale Agreement from the seller, TRI-B Associates LLP, for \$1,205,000. In addition to the purchase price and the City's due diligence and transactional costs, DPR is requesting \$275,000 for the demolition of the 1,800 square foot building on 4458 North Pearl Street and a Vision Plan, bringing the total acquisition cost to \$1,525,000. The remaining \$25,000 acquisition budget will be funded through a grant made by the Denver Park Trust.
