A RESOLUTION

Approving and providing for the execution of a proposed amended Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Public Safety concerning the “Juvenile Diversion Program” program and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed amended Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado Department of Public Safety, Division of Criminal Justice, for the “Victims of Crime Act” (VOCA) program, which is identified as Grant Number 2024-DV-24-30001-02, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 202370340-02, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the Colorado Department of Public Safety, Division of Criminal Justice, to the City pursuant to and under the amended Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 12000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the District Attorney, is as follows:

The foregoing amendment increases the current grant authorization from \$394,000 to \$609,000. Expenditures of said funds are authorized from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2024.

Section 4. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Resolution.
