ActiveNet is the primary Point of Sale/ Recreation Management Software system used for the Denver Parks & Recreation Department. ActiveNet is currently used by the following DPR Divisions/work group areas: Recreation (all 30 Recreation Centers, 16 outdoor pools, CityWide Sports, Outdoor Recreation, and Community & Adaptive Recreation), Parks Permitting (all permitting of athletic fields, picnic sites, special events, special occasions, races/walks, etc.), Event Venues, Chief Hosa Campground, Buffalo Bill Museum and several of our Cultural Partners. ActiveNet also has a customer portal for customers to complete online transactions for activity registrations, memberships, and facility reservations. Currently, there are over 750,000 customers in the data base and nearly 1,000 internal staff using the system.

This contract amendment will allow for continued use of the Point of Sale / Recreation Management Software and vendor support per our Service Level Agreement.
