A BILL

For an ordinance approving a proposed Second Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and State of Colorado Office of the Alternate Defense Counsel, to continue providing counsel for indigent criminal defendants when a conflict exists for the Office of the Municipal Public Defender, citywide.
