A BILL

For an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed grant agreement between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado concerning the "UASI FY23" program and the funding therefor, and authorizing the purchase of capital equipment items from the "UASI FY23" Special Revenue Fund budget.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver serves as the regional administrator for the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) program, which includes purchasing capital equipment for Denver as well as other jurisdictions in Denver’s regional area; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement between the State of Colorado, Department of Public Safety Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, and the City and County of Denver, which is identified as Grant Number EMW-2022-SS-00050, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 202370961, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the State of Colorado to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 12000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program be expended by the Director of Emergency Management and Homeland Security are as follows:

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Authorization for expenditure of said funds will cover the period from October 18, 2023 to August 31, 2026.


Section 4. From the Public Safety Special Revenue Fund, 12000, the Executive Director of the Office of Emergency Management or his duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:

Section 5. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
