A BILL

For an ordinance making a rescission from and an appropriation in the Culture and Recreation Special Revenue Fund Series to make a cash transfer to Parks Legacy Capital Improvement Funds.

WHEREAS, in 2018, Denver voters approved Ballot Measure 2A, which increased the sales tax rate by 0.25 percentage points starting January 1, 2019, to be spent on various programs and projects that support Parks, Trails and Open Space: and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has a signed Purchase and Sale Agreement from the seller, BSD High Line LLC, for the acquisition of 2369 South Quebec Street, an ~1.2-acre parcel located in Denver’s Goldsmith neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to transfer cash from the Parks Legacy Special Revenue Fund to Parks Legacy Capital Improvement Projects Funds to provide funding in support of the acquisition of 2369 South Quebec Street;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From appropriations heretofore made from the Culture and Recreation Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 15000, listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded":
