A BILL

For an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Denver Health and Hospital Authority, to continue connecting 9-1-1 callers with low acuity medical complaints with Denver Health NurseLine as an alternative to receiving ambulatory care, citywide.
