A BILL

For an ordinance making a rescission from General Fund Contingency and making appropriations to agency General Fund budgets, Special Revenue Funds, and authorizing cash transfers.

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure requests \$500,000 to support cost related increases to the cost of fuel, vehicle, and equipment parts; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney’s Office requests \$500,000 to cover increases to personnel from pay equity audits and increases to outside legal counsel contracts; and

WHEREAS, the Denver District Attorney’s Office requests \$100,000 to cover increases to personnel from pay equity audits; and

WHEREAS, the Independent Monitor requests \$100,000 to cover increases to personnel from pay equity audits; and

WHEREAS, Denver Human Services requests \$1,244,000 to support personnel and services and supplies costs related to support for asylum seekers coming into Denver from outside of the US border; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Internal Billings and Reimbursements Special Revenue Fund requires a total increase of \$450,000 for increased Police personnel costs at the Airport due to overtime and collective bargaining increases, which will be offset by billings revenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From appropriations heretofore made from the General Fund listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded" and transferred to the General Fund:
