A BILL

For an ordinance making a rescission, appropriation, and a cash transfer from Denver Human Services Special Revenue Fund to the Border Crisis Response Special Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS, the City desires to reallocate funds from the Denver Human Services Special Revenue Fund to the Denver Human Services Border Crisis Response Special Revenue Fund; and

WHEREAS, said funds will support personnel and services and supplies costs related to support for asylum seekers coming into Denver from outside of the US border;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From appropriations heretofore made from the Human Services Special Revenue Fund, listed or indicated in the following tabulation, there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded":

Section 2. From the Human Services Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 13000, out of monies rescinded from Section 1 and from cash balances in the same, said fund, and not otherwise appropriated and in addition to amounts heretofore appropriated by Ordinance No. 1446, Series of 2022, and any supplemental appropriations or rescissions, there is hereby appropriated to the appropriation accounts hereinafter designated the amount of money following such designation, to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:

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The foregoing appropriation is to make cash a transfer to the “Border Crisis Response Special Revenue Fund” (13809) in the Human Services Special Revenue Fund Series to support programs and services for migrants and asylum seekers arriving in Denver from other countries.

Section 3. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
