## Sec. 18-81. Salaries.

(a) In accordance with the limitations on the salaries of elected Charter officers as set forth in section 9.2.2 of the Charter, the council hereby fixes the annual salaries for the term beginning July 17, 2023, as follows:

Members of the Denver City Council	\$110,595.76
Clerk and Recorder	\$178,152.24

(b) Beginning July 19, 2027, and on the third Monday of July following the general City and
