13	WHEREAS, the city has received JUUL/vaping settlement revenue related to a nationwide,	
14	youth vaping lawsuit and anticipates receiving additional settlement funds related to nicotine	
15	products and vaping over the course of the next four years; and	
16	WHEREAS, the City wishes to update the Tobacco Sting Special Revenue Fund name and	
17	purpose to include all nicotine products (including vaping), as well as to expand the allowable	
18	revenue and expenditures;

1	Section 2. Monies received from contributions, donations, project incomes,		
2	nicotine-related settlements, or other source of private receipts shall be		
3	deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 14000		
4	which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code		
5	of the City and County of Denver.

7	Section 3. Expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Tobacco		
8	StingComprehensive Nicotine Control" fund, Auditor's No. 14804-6500000, in the		
9	amount not to exceed the total of deposits described in Section 2 of this		
10	Ordinance, to be expended by the Manager of Environmental Health.

12	Section 2. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized		
13	and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary		
14	to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
