

# Department of Transportation and Infrastructure 2024 On-Call Construction Services Bridge & Structural Project Delivery (LARGE)

#### **Fact Sheet**

## **Purpose of Procurement**

The City identified the need to establish a group of qualified <u>On-Call General Contractors</u> available to respond to bidding requests for the City's construction work. This work includes <u>construction work on bridges</u>, <u>culverts</u>, <u>and/or miscellaneous structures that facilitate vehicular and pedestrian traffic as well as electrical elements that facilitate lighting in these areas.</u> At the time the need was identified, it was anticipated that <u>7-8 contracts</u> would be awarded for <u>three-year</u> terms at <u>\$30M</u> each. DSBO's review of the scope of work and associated tasks (outlined below) resulted in an <u>MWBE</u> goal of <u>12</u>%.

## **Funding**

Funding <u>is not</u> committed at this time. Authorization of work and commitment of funds are made via work order on an as-needed basis.



### **Procurement**

The Selection Criteria for this procurement were reviewed by the Selection Committee and approved by DOTI Executive Management in <u>December 2023</u>. The criteria used to evaluate the submittals includes: <u>Contractor Qualifications</u>, <u>Personnel Qualifications</u>, <u>Project Expertise</u>, <u>Project Approach</u>, <u>Technical Accuracy</u>, <u>Quality and Safety</u>, <u>Diversity and Inclusiveness</u>, <u>Bonding Capacity</u>, <u>and Contractors Prequalification</u>.

Advertisement of the Request for Qualifications began on <u>September 13, 2023</u>, and submittals were due <u>October 18, 2020</u>. <u>Six (6)</u> firms responded to the Request for Qualifications; all submittals were reviewed and scored by the Selection Committee; <u>six (6)</u> firms were directly selected to contract with the City.
