6 7	For an ordinance naming an unnamed park at Iliff Ave. and Bellaire St. "Bethesda Park".				
8 9	WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver acquired the land on which a park sits, an				
10	unnamed park at Iliff Ave. and Bellaire St., within the City and County Denver, in 2019, located at				
11	4301 E Iliff Ave, Denver, Colorado 80222; and				
12	WHEREAS, the park was designated in accordance with City Charter in 2022; and				
13	WHEREAS, in accordance with the procedure established by the Department of Parks and				
14	Recreation's Naming Policy, a neighborhood committee submitted a proposal to the Parks and				
15	Recreation Advisory Board to name the park "Bethesda Park"; and				
16	WHEREAS, the purpose of the naming is to honor the impact that the Bethesda				
17	Tuberculosis Sanitorium, later the Bethesda Psychiatric Hospital, had on the community including				
18	the several generations of immigrants near and arounds the park; and to honor the Dutch heritage				
19	of the neighborhood. "Bethesda" is a Hebrew word meaning place or house of mercy, aptly				
20	reflecting the values of charity and service held by the founders of the Sanitorium and the Hospita				
21	as well as the community. When first established the Sanitorium served the local Dutch immigrant				
22	community. Over the years, other immigrant and local communities were served by the Sanitorium				
23	and Hospital.				
24	WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation supports the				
25	proposed naming of this park; and				
26	WHEREAS, the Denver Parks and Recreation Advisory Board voted at its meeting on				
27	January 10, 2024, to recommend the naming of the unnamed park as "Bethesda Park".				
28	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:				
29	Section 1. That the park, the same is hereby named, and shall be known as, BETHESE				
30	PARK.				
31	<b>Section 2</b> . That this action shall be effective upon the final adoption of the ordinance.
