6 7 8 9	For an ordinance amending Ordinance No. 457, Series of 2001 concerning the "Tobacco Sting" Special Revenue Fund (14804) to update outdated language to expand the allowable purpose of the fund.
10	WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 457 Series of 2001 established Fund 14804, a Health Special
11	Revenue Fund, for the purpose of conducting tobacco sales compliance assessments and related
12	activities; and
13	WHEREAS, the city has received JUUL/vaping settlement revenue related to a nationwide,
14	youth vaping lawsuit and anticipates receiving additional settlement funds related to nicotine
15	products and vaping over the course of the next four years; and
16	WHEREAS, the City wishes to update the Tobacco Sting Special Revenue Fund name and
17	purpose to include all nicotine products (including vaping), as well as to expand the allowable
18	revenue and expenditures;

20	NOW, THERFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY
21	OF DENVER:

23	Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance 457, Series of 2001, is hereby amended to read as
24	follows:

26	"Section 1. There is hereby established in the Health Special Revenue
27	Fund, Auditor's No. 14000, a "Tobacco StingComprehensive Nicotine Control"
28	fund, Auditor's No. 14804-6500000, for the purpose of conducting tobacco
29	salesnicotine prevention, education, cessation, compliance, assessments
30	mitigation and related activities, with a focus, not exclusively, on youth and young
31	<u>adults</u> .
