¿Qué es Colorado Connect?

Colorado Connect ayuda a cualquier residente de Colorado a acceder a beneficios de salud, productos de seguros médicos y servicios de calidad para mejorar su bienestar general.

Colorado Connect es una plataforma de compras que se creó para abordar las disparidades en la cobertura y la atención médica. La entidad fue diseñada para administrar planes de cobertura de salud individuales y asistencia financiera financiada por el estado a los residentes de Colorado elegibles, independientemente de su estatus migratorio (incluyendo los beneficiarios de DACA).

Recursos disponibles para residentes de Colorado sin seguro, independientemente de su estatus migratorio:

- Atención hospitalaria con descuento
- Clínicas de red de seguridad, centros de salud calificados a nivel federal y clínicas de salud rurales
- Programa de Atención a Indigentes de Colorado
- Medicaid de Emergencia
- Ahorros en recetas y atención medica a través de NeedyMeds.org



SilverEnhanced Savings

Silver Enhanced Savings es el tipo de ayuda financiera que se brinda a los habitantes de Colorado que son indocumentados y que compran en Colorado Connect.

- Silver Enhanced Savings solo está disponible en Colorado Connect
- Solo se aplica a planes de nivel Plata y no está disponible para todas las personas del Programa OmniSalud
- Los clientes elegibles podrán comprar un plan de nivel plata con primas de \$0 y las aseguradoras pagarán el 94% de los costos médicos.
- Ganar menos del 150% de la Línea Federal de Pobreza lo calificará para los planes Silver Enhanced Savings.



¿Qué es Omnisalud?

OmniSalud no es un producto o servicio, sino simplemente un término utilizado para referirse a los habitantes de Colorado indocumentados. OmniSalud se traduce como "Toda Salud." El nombre se le dio al programa Health Insurance Affordability Enterprise (HIAE), por su nombre en inglés, que permite a los residentes de Colorado indocumentados comprar y comparar planes en Colorado Connect. La ayuda financiera proporcionada a través de este programa y en la plataforma Colorado Connect se llama Silver Enhanced Savings.







Colorado Connect cumple con la Ley de Privacidad de 1974, que cubre el flujo de información entre el gobierno federal y el mercado. La Ley impide que las agencias federales revelen información sobre un individuo sin su consentimiento a menos que exista una excepción especial. La información sobre estatus migratorio se mantiene confidencial y solo se utiliza para verificar las calificaciones del programa. Cuando llene su solicitud, puede optar por compartir su información sólo con Colorado Connect.

Últimas Actualizaciones

Se ofertaron 10.000 plazas para la cobertura 2023 y 11.000 plazas para la cobertura 2024 en el Programa OmniSalud.

Las inscripciones 2024 en los planes de ahorro SilverEnhanced cerraron a las 2:45 p.m. el 2 de noviembre de 2023. Se determinó que 11,004 personas eran elegibles. El 30.25 % de las personas que se determinaron elegibles son clientes que regresan de la cobertura de 2023.







Impacto Comunitario

"Soy madre soltera de tres hijos, uno de los cuales tiene necesidades especiales. Soy una inmigrante colombiana y sobreviviente de violencia doméstica... El seguro proporciona a mi maravilloso hijo con necesidades especiales recursos inmensamente beneficiosos. Este programa resalta para mí la buena voluntad y las oportunidades que pueden surgir al vivir en Colorado a pesar de los obstáculos que he tenido que superar. Gracias por crear un programa tan maravilloso y por creer en nuestra contribución como inmigrantes a este país. Mi familia y yo estamos agradecidos".

Ahora Pt ha perdido la cobertura; tuvo cita [de inscripción] el 3 de noviembre. No pude inscribirme debido a que las plazas se llenaron en un día. Pt dice que no podrá continuar [en 2024] con el nivel de atención preventiva y continua que se brindó bajo Omni".
