CURRENT BOARD STATUS

Scope of Board/Commission: The Denver Community Corrections Board oversees the acceptance and rejection criteria for all offenders considered for placement in the Denver Community Corrections Residential program.

The Board is made up of representatives across the criminal justice spectrum.

- 10 represent criminal justice and human services departments, One represents Victim Services, Two have experience or expertise in criminal justice, Six are citizens of the City and County of Denver, One is a locally elected official, One is a representative of Denver Public Schools

Appointment Process: The Board has 21 members who are appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council for 4 year terms.
