A BILL

For an ordinance approving a resolution requesting the renewal and continuance of the Santa Fe Business Improvement District for an additional ten-year period.

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe Business Improvement District (the “District”) was initiated by petition filed with the City Clerk, ex-officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk File No. 2014-0631, and was created and established pursuant to Ordinance No. 0463, Series of 2014; and

WHEREAS, the District’s initial Operating Plan directs that, unless otherwise approved by the City Council, the District will have an initial ten-year term (“Initial Term”); and

WHEREAS, the District’s initial Operating Plan further directs that the Initial Term will allow for property owners within the District to evaluate the District’s effectiveness at the end of the Initial Term and, if the District is deemed successful, then the Board of Directors of the District (the “Board”) will request that the City Council renew the District by ordinance after the Initial Term; and

WHEREAS, the District’s initial Operating Plan further directs that if the District is not considered to be successful, then it will sunset at the end of the Initial Term; and

WHEREAS, the Board held a public hearing on extending the District’s term on April 16, 2024, and thereafter adopted a resolution determining, among other things, that the District has been successful and should be extended for another ten (10) year term (the “Renewal Resolution”); and

WHEREAS, the Renewal Resolution has been filed with the City Clerk, ex-officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk Filing No. 20240049 on April 26, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Renewal Resolution satisfies the threshold required by the District’s initial Operating Plan that the District has been successful over the prior ten-year period and demonstrates support for the renewal and continuation of the District for another ten-year period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The Renewal Resolution satisfies the threshold established by the District’s initial Operating Plan that the District has been successful over the prior ten-year period and

1 demonstrates support for the renewal and continuation of the District for another ten-year term, which
2 shall run through December 31, 2034 (the “Renewal Term”).

3 **Section 2.** The City Council hereby approves the renewal and continuation of the District
4 for the Renewal Term and upon its conclusion, unless it is otherwise renewed and continued, the
5 District shall sunset and dissolve in accordance with C.R.S. § 31-25-1225, as may be amended from
6 time to time. The District may seek the City Council’s consent for the District’s further renewal and
7 continuation for a subsequent ten-year term prior to the end of the Renewal Term in accordance with
8 the procedures set forth in the District’s initial Operating Plan and as further described herein.
