A BILL

For an ordinance making a cash transfer from the Coronavirus Emergency Response Special Revenue Fund to the Homelessness Resolution Fund and making an appropriation in and the Homelessness Resolution Fund.

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Emergency Response Special Revenue Fund (SRF) was established through Ordinance No. 293, Series of 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Finance (DOF) applied for federal reimbursement for FEMA-eligible expenses, anticipating that these reimbursements would be made in 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City utilized the Homelessness Resolution Fund to support expenses related to shelter and outreach that were reimbursable under FEMA with the knowledge that these dollars were forthcoming; and

WHEREAS, the city wishes to transfer cash from FEMA reimbursements to the Department of Housing Stability’s (HOST) Homelessness Resolution Fund and establish an appropriation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1: There is hereby authorized the transfer of cash in the amount indicated in the following tabulation:
