Approves a contract with Jones Lang LaSalle Americas, Inc for \$890,664 and for five years to provide software solution services to support facility compliance governance for city-owned buildings, including a secure database for regulatory-driven document storage, management of regulated and hazardous waste disposal requests, and real-time information on locations of regulated building materials, ensuring safer and more efficient building renovations and remediation, citywide (ESEQD-202371354).

Jones Lang LaSalle (JLL) will provide the Archibus software and applicable software module creations for Environmental Quality. It will move the end-to-end business process for the Facility Compliance program into a secure and comprehensive software solution, including facility compliance, contractor/vendor communications, and document management. For the Asbestos program, Archibus will allow for advanced mapping of floorplans and city-owned buildings for compliance related inspections. This software solution will aid Environmental Quality in the compliance governance performed on behalf of all CCD-owned facilities by creating a fully supported, secure database for regulatory-driven document storage, provide opportunities for on the spot dispatch of regulated and hazardous waste disposal requests to existing hazmat contractors, and provide real-time information on locations of regulated building materials; e.g. asbestos, ensuring safer and more efficient building renovations and remediation when needed. This software will help bridge a gap between known compliance requirements and aging existing technology currently in use.

Scope of work:

JLL will provide the Archibus software for Environmental Quality. It will move the end-to-end business process for the Environmental Facility Compliance program into a secure and comprehensive software solution, including facility compliance, contractor/vendor communications, and document management. For the Asbestos program, Archibus will allow for advanced mapping of floorplans and city-owned buildings for compliance related inspections, allowing for quick feedback on known locations of regulated building materials; e.g. asbestos, found in most CCD-owned facilities prior to disturbance during renovations or emergency structural work.

Was this contractor selected by competitive process? No **If not, why not?** We vetted multiple existing software solutions within the City’s available options, including Accela, but all would require more resources to customize the platform, whereas Archibus already has all the required fields and functionality “out of the box” that our Hazardous Waste and Asbestos programs require. This software is made specifically to cater to government organizations with multiple environmental compliance modules already built into the platform, requiring limited customization which greatly adds to cost and can impact overall functionality. Additionally, we require floorplans/mapping/polylining solutions that no other software platform provides and integrates. This software is also currently in use under contract by Real Estate which will allow for integration of existing floorplan mapping and polylining to be utilized by Environmental Quality, saving additional resources.
