A RESOLUTION

Approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States of America Department of Health and Human Services concerning the “Mental Health & Awareness Grant” for the DenverStrong program and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement, under CFDA 93.243, between the City and County of Denver and the United States of America Department of Health and Human Services, for the “Mental Health & Awareness Grant” for the DenverStrong program, which is identified as Grant Number 5H79SM084661-04, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 202160319-03, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the United States of America Department of Health and Human Services to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 14000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment, is as follows:

The foregoing amendment increases the current grant authorization from \$375,000 to \$500,000. Expenditures of said funds are authorized from September 30, 2021 to September 29, 2025.

3 to accomplish the purposes of this Resolution.
