5. General description or background of proposed request. Attach executive summary if more space needed:

In alignment with the City and County of Denver's and Vision 100's values, Denver International Airport (DEN) developed the voluntary Excellence in Service (EIS) program for concessionaires. This program motivates and rewards top-performing concessionaires by offering a 3-year contract extension to those who qualify. EIS scoring is based on assessments in Equity, Diversity, Inclusion, and Accessibility (EDIA), Airport Certified Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE), Environmental Sustainability, and Customer Service. To receive the contract extension, concessionaires must achieve a score of 90% or higher across these categories. Concessionaires must also maintain contract compliance. The award can only be earned one-time, and after the extended contract term, the space will be re-bid through the Request for Proposal (RFP) process.

DEN requests City Council to approve the three (3) year extension for Contract PLANE-202474585.

Scope of work:

To amend the current lease of McDonald's USA, LLC dba McDonald's on Concourse B Center Core Food Court which has earned the EIS Program Benefit of a 3-year contract extension. In addition to the contract extension, DEN and the Concessionaire have agreed to update the American Disabilities Act (ADA), Certified Annual Statement (CAS) Requirement, and Minority Women Owned Business Enterprise (MWBE) Provisions in the contract. These provisions are to bring the contracts into standards with the current concessions contract and to ensure that our concession spaces remain regulatory compliant. In alignment with the Concessions Master Plan, the square feet of this operation has increased to 1,692.2 square feet, which now leases the queuing area into the Concessions Leased Area.
