12 necessity no longer requires the easement in the above-referenced Permanent Easement for Right-

15 **Section 1.** That the action of the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation  
16 and Infrastructure in relinquishing of the easement, in its entirety, established in the Permanent  
17 Easement for Right-of-Way Area recorded with the Denver Clerk & Recorder at Reception No.  
18 2024053812 be and the same is hereby approved and that the easement in the above-described  
19 Permanent Easement for Right-of-Way Area is hereby relinquished.
