6 **For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase from the Public**
7 **Health State Grants Special Revenue Fund.**

9 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Health and Environment (DDPHE) is seeking
10 approval to purchase a vehicle to support the Road to Recovery program funded from the
11 "Criminal Justice Early Intervention Grant" program, which was approved via Resolution 951,
12 Series of 2024; and

13 **WHEREAS**, said purchase will be authorized from the DDPHE "Criminal Justice Early
14 Intervention" Grant program budget (14003-6500000); and

15 **WHEREAS**, said vehicle is over the \$50,000 threshold for capital equipment items that
16 require City Council approval, per the Denver Revised Municipal Code;

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY**

21 **Section 1.** From the Public Health State Grants Fund, Accounting No. 14003, the Executive
22 Director of the Denver Department of Health Environment, or duly authorized representatives, is
23 hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:
